Resolution Adopted by the Council of the European Union

The Situation of Illegal Immigrants in Europe

Bearing in mind the problems that the illegal immigration causes and how affects the economy of the European nations,

Noting the conditions in the nations from which most of the illegal immigrants come,

Observing the illegal immigrants who are living in Europe,

Realizing that it would not be possible and functional to deport all the illegal immigrants established in the European Union,

1. *Recommends* providing legal processes to those illegal immigrants who have been in the European Union for a time established by the Migration department and present a profile of a good citizen able to handle responsibilities as legal residents and/or European citizens;
2. *Calls* for nations to increase the number of legal immigrants allowed to enter their nations to strength the economy, since the elderly in Europe is bigger than the active working citizens;
3. *Calls upon* nations to create an European governmental institution for those illegal immigrants who want to become residents in order to guide them of the legalization process;
4. *Encourages* nations to make it a priority to enforce the law that makes it illegal to help people cross the border illegally;
5. *Asks* countries to fortify security check points where vehicles and passport are checked on the borders of the European Union.

The Global Impact of the Growth of the European Union

Affirming that the European Union is made for growth, aware of how it affects the world,

Keeping in mind the leading position the European Union must take,

Taking into consideration that there are still challenges that the European Union faces,

The Council of the European Union,

1. *Recommends* that the each members state of the European Union adopts the Euro as the official currency;
2. Further recommends that new members states that want to adopt the Euro must first meet the monetary goals of the European Union;
3. Further requests that in case of emergency to pull troops from each members state to act in major crisis called by the authorities of the European Union;
4. Calls upon European Union states to continue financially supporting the European Union cooperating for the developing areas of the region and the rest of the world;
5. Confirms that the European Union is only an intermediary when conflicting nations request aid;
6. Declares according that all potential members must be examined closely to make sure the Copenhagen Criteria has been met.
